


He is the founding editor of *Home School Researcher*, a quarterly peer-reviewed journal on home education; has published numerous articles on home education in professional journals (e.g., *Peabody Journal of Education*, *Educational Leadership*), *Christianity Today*, and *The Old Schoolhouse* magazine; has been interviewed by numerous radio, print, and television media, including two appearances on the “NBC Today Show” with presidents of the National Education Association; is a former professor of education at the undergraduate and graduate levels; is a former classroom teacher in private and public schools; and takes a logical and friendly approach to home education. His Ph.D. is in science education from Oregon State University. His newest books are *Home Educated and Now Adults* and *Worldwide Guide to Homeschooling* (available online www.nheri.org). Dr. and Mrs. Ray homeschooled all of their eight children (and they have eleven grandchildren), and live on a small farm in western Oregon.
